# **General Setup Instructions**

- Read entire setup instruction manual prior to unpacking parts and pieces.
- The setup instructions are created specifically for this configuration.
- Setup instructions are laid out sequentially in steps, including exploded views with detailed explanation for assembly.

# Cleaning & Packing

- For Cleaning Metal, Plex, & Laminate Parts: Use a MILD NON-ABRASIVE cleanser and soft cloth/paper towel to clean all surfaces.
- Keep exhibit components away from heat and prolonged sun exposure. Heat and UV exposure will warp and fade components.
- Retain all provided Packing Materials. All provided packing materials are for ease of repacking & component protection.

# Disassembly

- For loss prevention, tighten all set screws and locks during disassembly.

#### Static Mode:

- 1. Use the Color Ring key to select a color.
- 2. Saturation is controlled with W/R/G/B keys.
- 4. Colors (not white) are dimmable with the Brightness key.

#### Dynamic Mode:

- Press "M" key to cycle through the following options: 1. White light fades in and out.
- 2. Several colors fade in and out
- 3. R,G,B three colors fade in and out.
- 4. R,G,B three colors flash. 5. Six colors flash.
- 6. Random color flashes
- 7. Red color fades in and flashes.
- 8. Green color fades in and flashes. 9. Blue color fades in and flashes.

#### To Pair a Remote with Multiple Units: 1. Power on the lights.

2. Press 'ON' key within 3 seconds. 3. Lights will blink when link is made. To unpair: Long press 'ON' key within 3 seconds after switching on lights.

Remotes can be paired with one or more receivers. Different receivers can work synchronously even when started at different times (within 30 min).

#### Steps:

- 1) Connect Cabinets [A] & [B] together using roto cam locks. See Roto Cam Lock Connection detail.
- 2) Assemble Wall Panels [F1-F2] together using roto cam locks. See Roto Cam Lock Connection detail.
- 3) Use bolts to connect Wall Panel [F1] to nut serts on side of Cabinet [B]. See Bolt to Nut Sert Connection detail.

Steps:

- 1) Attach plex panels inside of Cabinets [C] and [D], using standoffs and screw caps. .
- 2) Connect Cabinets [C] & [D] together using roto cam locks. See Roto Cam Lock Connection detail.
- 3) Use bolts and screw caps to connect Wall Panel [F2/F1]back of Cabinets [C] & [D]. See Bolt to Nut Sert Connection detail.

2) Attach keyboard Shelf to backwall panels [F1], See Roto Cam Lock Connection.

#### Steps:

- 1) Place Greeting Counter in front of backwall assembly, as shown on layout.
- 2) Connect power cords to Supernova lights inside Greeting Counter, as shown.
- 3) Attach power cords to Supernova lights inside Cabinets [A & B]. Transformers are permanently attached to the back side of panel [F1].
- 4) Connect power cords to Supernova lights inside Cabinets [C & D]. Transformers are permanently attached to the back side of panel [F1]. Note: Refer to the Supernova Lighting page for instructions.
